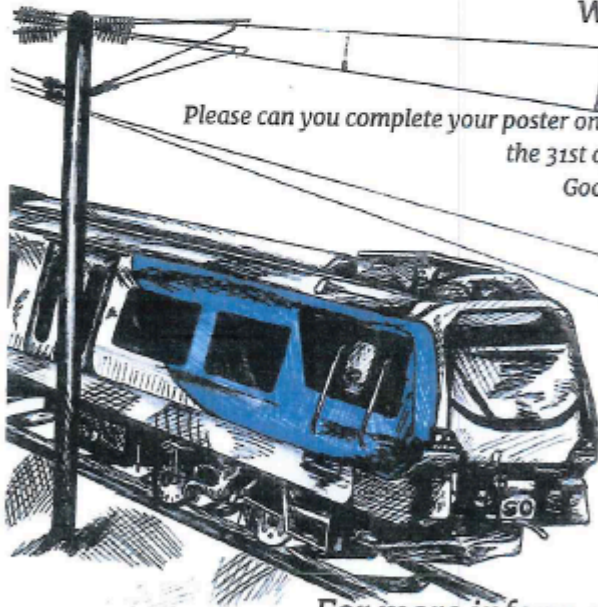


Sandbach Station Poster Competition.

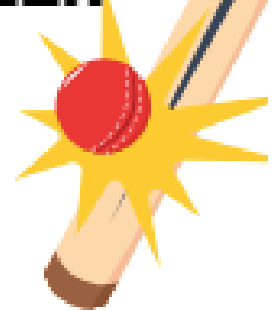
